- ANY current Associate, Affiliate or Builder Member is eligible to serve on a committee. In order to Chair or Co-Chair a Committee, you must be an Associate or Builder Member.
- All Committee Members act as “Committee Ambassadors” at organized AHBA events as offered throughout the year (Networking Nights, Annual Meeting, Preview Event, etc.)
- Committees meet at the AHBA Office on average once a month or once every other month. Members must maintain 60% attendance.

AHBA COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

All members who serve on an AHBA committee, assume an important role in the association through these leadership positions. All Committees work with the AHBA Staff, Committee Chairs and Board of Directors.

MEMBERSHIP/RETENTION

An AHBA Staff lead committee focusing on membership through recruiting and retention. Works with Staff to monitor membership statistics and establishes goals and incentives for membership growth and development. Assists with planning and executing new member orientations, membership drives, and welcoming new members

- *Meets on the 2nd Tuesday of every month starting in January from 3:30 to 4:30pm.*

SOCIAL/ACTIVITIES

Works closely with the AHBA Staff to coordinate and promote FUN events for the general membership creating networking and relationship building opportunities including the AHBA Annual Golf Tournament, AHBA Night at the Tourists, Holiday Social, and Home & Garden Expo.

- *Meets on the 4th Tuesday of every other month starting in February from 3:30 to 4:30pm.*

PARADE OF HOMES

Plans and promotes the annual Parade of Homes held in October also encompassing the Parade of Homes Preview Event held in February and the AHBA Fall Awards Gala and Reception. Members assist with recruiting entries, coordinating judging day volunteers and more.

- *Meets on the 1st Thursday of every month starting in January from 3:30 to 4:30pm.*

EDUCATION

Responsible for planning, implementing and promoting member education classes offered throughout the year including Quarterly Builder Breakfast education sessions as well as determining the interest and need for education topics for the general membership.

- *Meets once a quarter in February, April, July, October on the 1st Tuesday from 3:30 to 4:30pm.*

LEGISLATIVE

Coordinates member involvement and acts as a liaison in the local, state and national government and political activities that affect the housing industry. Meets with local elected officials, discusses ordinances and promotes BUILD-PAC contributions.

- *Meets on the 3rd Tuesday, once per quarter from 3:30 to 4:30pm at the AHBA Office*

PROFESSIONAL WOMEN IN BUILDING (PWB) COUNCIL

Fosters the professional development among women and men within the building industry through networking, educational events and community outreach events. Participants plan, implement and promote the annual PWB Council Scholarship Fundraising event held in July.

- *Meets on the 4th Wednesday of March, July and November on-site at member locations for lunch networking meetings from 12noon to 1:30pm. Meets on the 4th Wednesday of January, May and September for an educational seminar at the AHBA Office from 3:30 to 4:30pm.*
