



AHBA Professional Women in Building Council 2010 Scholarship Criteria Information Page

To be eligible for scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria. These guidelines will apply in accepting applications for the PWB Scholarship fund:

1. **Length of Time:** Scholarships will be awarded for one year. Scholarships will not automatically renew, but students may reapply each year.
2. **Scholarship Number & Amount:** The PWB Board of Directors and the PWB Scholarship Committee will determine the number of scholarships and the amount awarded, based on the availability of funds.
3. **Eligibility:** Scholarships will be awarded to students in their senior year of high school and/or attending a college or technical school. Both full and part time students are eligible.
4. **Timetable:** Scholarship applications will be accepted beginning with the fall term each year. The PWB Board of Directors and the PWB Scholarship Committee will meet in February to select the scholarship recipients. The scholarship winners will be notified by letter and announced each year no later than March.
5. **Criteria:** Scholarships will be awarded based on merit as determined by the PWB Board of Directors and the PWB Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be awarded to students attending a college, technical school or a senior in high school with in North Carolina and studying in a construction related field. For college students (must have completed one full semester) please send your official college transcripts when submitting your application.
4. You will be invited as an honored guest to an AHBA General Membership Meeting to receive your award in June 2010.
